The Wollombi Valley Sculpture Festival for 2021 will be very different from what we were planning.

We have selected 61 large outdoor sculptures and 89 indoor pieces from over 300 entries to exhibit this year.

We had chosen the outdoor sites and selected which of the 7 indoor galleries each of the finalists works would have been displayed and for sale in.

We are so disappointed to have had to cancel the festival due to COVID and our absolute responsibility to keep our valley safe.

The exciting news is we are still putting on a show.

The 2021 festival is now an Online Event.

We have produced an Online Catalogue where our finalists can sell their work and our sculpture loving friends can still buy sculpture.

We have reduced our commission so our sculptors now get 80% of the catalogue price which we hope will help in these difficult times.

An incredible amount of work has gone into the preparation of this year's festival and we thank over 100 locals who had volunteered to help as well as our patrons, supporters and sponsors for their ongoing financial generosity.

All the sculptures selected to exhibit this year are automatically eligible to exhibit in 2022 and new works by the sculptors can also be entered for selection.

Next year will be our 20th anniversary and we are looking forward to seeing you all for a huge show.



Title: **Variation on a Theorem** Price: \$1,950 Materials: Steel plate and tubing, powder coat finish

Dimensions: 100h x 90w x 2d cm

Pythagoras's Theorem is commonly represented in design and occurs frequently in nature.

This sculpture uses powder coated steel in bright colours as a variation on that theorem.

Materials: Sand cement, iron, wire Dimensions: 230h x 225w x 800d cm

The Awakening of Og. The King of Bashan, the last Nephilim giant to walk the earth was slain at the battle of Edrei by Moses and the Hebrews in 3000BC. Og awakening is the giant's current grip on corrosive corruption in our modern world.

Title: **Hermes of the Parthenon** Price: \$1,450 Materials: Clay mediums, concrete, fibreglass, metal

Hermes is an Olympian deity. The flying foot of this ancient Greek God is all that remains of the lost world in the ruins of the Parthenon. Hand-sculptured in Wed Clay, fibreglassed and plated with liquid copper patina on marble plate.

Life Study is integral to the sculptor, providing both form and expression. I am invited to the figure; the way it holds itself; how emotion and personality are conveyed through the pose; beguiling in its nature. You become spellbound as you capture the moment in clay.



The Firetree series is a set of sculptures that investigates twisted material tensions in the steel as line and form and as drawings in space. They are forms regarding shapes of blaze of fire and poverty of water.

The piece presents the aspect of the void as equally important as the material substance of the work, it gives the work volume and presence, it is a paradoxical transformation of materiality. 

importance of community.







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


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WENDY BLACK - Watagan, NSW

A combination of wire, antique pressed tin, wool and fibres in an elemental representation of drifting without destination. Wild organic patterns; oxidised blossoms of metal, a tangle of rusted wire and a haven of indigo blue wool are a tribute to the textile traditions of the seminomadic Tuareg people.

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


Title: **Twist and Pop** Price: \$48,000 Materials: 316 Marine grade stainless steel, polished

This spiraling stainless steel piece is a modern interpretation of the sophisticated and stylish icon. Designed and fabricated entirely by the artist.

One of several species of Raven in Australia, the Little Raven, lives in diverse habitats across the continent's southeast. I am in awe and fascination of those in the Alpine region. Even amidst wild blizzards groups soar and swoop, call their harsh cry and huddle together in the snow gums.

Materials: Bronze, cement Dimensions: 24h x 10w x 9d cm

Created during the Victorian Covid lockdown periods, Balance explores the fine balance between the individual and the weight of external forces including social, political and environmental concerns as well as the pressures and expectations of contemporary life.

Dimensions: 18h x 21w x 7d cm

The Return explores the notion of the interconnected consciousness that is integral in the fight against climate change, habitat destruction and extinction.



CATHERINE GORRIE - Congewai, NSW

Title: La Femme Moderne Price: \$2,450

Materials: Huon Pine, brass Dimensions: 30h x 30w x 15d cm

Clean cut beauty from any angle, this feminine form speaks of sleek curves formed by woodturning, carving and metalworking. Huon Pine may be anything from 500-3000 years old and the piece is presented in its raw state so it will last as long as it took to grow.



ANNE GRAHAM - Kanimbla, NSW

Title: The Gardens of Stone Price: \$35.000

Materials: Felted wool, steel

Dimensions: 125h x 240w x 240d cm

I have used discarded wool blankets, rubbish from our affluent society, sourced from local Opportunity Shops. I have hand cut and dyed the blankets, inspired by the contours of the Pagodas of The Gardens of Stone with the intention of raising awareness of this beautiful and endangered place.


'Small hill', or 'hill of refuge' is the Dutch meaning of Hilje. This is the name of my sister who interestingly

St Michael's Church in the centre of Historic Wollombi Village is an amazing location for a unique and memorable wedding.


This beautiful sandstone church with lead light windows was built in 1840 and caters for weddings and celebrations for all denominations.

Chain reactions started by small actions - on streets, in neighbourhoods, on social media - can snowball and form part of a large collective action. Just as butterfly wings beating in the jungle can create chaos, so a ripple can give rise to huge global waves of political change.

As the title suggests, the inspiration for 'Blues 'n' Boogie' stems from listening to the improvised rhythms of jazz music. Although I listen to music when working in my studio, this visual representation relates to my body movement during the making rather than a specific musical score.

'The silence in-between' refers to the silence between notes in music critical to finding rhythm and beat much as space does in sculpture. This work of three parts allows for spontaneity and serendipity through the variations in the placement of each form inspired by the improvisation of jazz musicians.

The term solar comes from the Latin solis meaning sun. In Roman mythology, solar deities, often depicted as the 'eve' of the sun, evoke the power of sun worship. In my work Solar, the sun's power is celebrated as an 'eye' in the form of a hidden 'circle of light'.

Venture 1 is a bold new impression of the traditional horses head, evolved through many stages to get to this point: a piercing outline of sharp edges and striking

In recent years many living things have become victims of climate fires and people have struggled and had to reconsider their living style due to the alarm of Covid. This work is a celebration of a new era. (This ephemeral sculpture was to be made during the 2021 festival).



POLINA KARUSO - Sweetmans Creek, NSW

Title: **Reclamation** Price: \$1,650 Materials: Acrylic on reclaimed hardwood block

Dimensions: 30h x 12w x 9d cm

This sculpture represents the idea of reclaiming land taken during the colonial invasion, and restoring it to indigenous Australians. The timber used in the creation of this piece was sourced from a demolished colonial cottage and is inspired by an indigenous representation of the forest, like a STAMP returning this timber to its true beginning.
