# Introduction

The Fremantle Arts Centre Print Award has become established as an important exhibition in the annual Festival of Perth visual arts programme. This, the third Fremantle Arts Centre Print Award, has attracted a record number of 133 entries from all over Australia, as well as prints sent from London and New York by Australian printmakers living in those cities.

After examining all entries the judging panel selected 59 prints to be hung in the exhibition. The judges commented that the selection process, necessary because of limited hanging space, had resulted in an exhibition of a very high standard and that they were faced with an extremely difficult task in selecting the Award Print and recommending prints for purchase.

The Fremantle Arts Centre acknowledges the generous assistance of The Shell Company of Australia Limited in again providing \$500 for the Print Award and assistance in the collection and freighting of interstate entries. This year The Shell Company has also made available an additional \$250 for the purchase of recommended prints to add to the City of Fremantle collection.

The Arts Centre is also grateful for the special assistance this year from the Festival of Perth to stage the exhibition.

Finally, the exhibition would not have been possible without the support and enthusiasm of printmakers throughout Australia, who have made this the most successful Fremantle Arts Centre Print Award to date.
