The Royal Agricultural Society of N.S.W. invites Artists to submit paintings, sculptures, and ceramics for judging and exhibition at the Royal Easter Show.

Each painting, sculpture or ceramic must be the work of the Competitor and must have been completed within the two years prior to March, 1975.

Any painting, sculpture, or ceramic entered for the Art Prize Exhibitions conducted by this Society in 1973 and 1974 is not eligible for entry in this competition.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS

Exhibitors are reminded that the Society's General Regulations apply to all sections of the Show and that the Special Regulations hereunder set out which apply to these sections only are merely supplementary to the General Regulations.

REGULATIONS

ALL PRIZES ARE NON-ACQUISITIVE.

Medium:—Entries in Sections 1, 2, 3 and 5 must be painted in oils or synthetic mediums. Entries in Section 4 must be painted in watercolour. Entries in Sections 6 and 7 may be in any material form or style.

Size:—Frames to be included in following painting sizes: Paintings in Sections 1, 2, 3 and 5 must not exceed an area of 6' x 4' overall, including frame, or equivalent area and be not smaller than 20" x 15" overall, including frame, or equivalent area. Paintings in Section 4 must not exceed 30" x 40" overall, including frame, or equivalent area, and be not smaller than 18" x 15" overall, including frame, or equivalent area. In Sections 6 and 7 paintings and relief sculptures must not exceed 6' x 4'; sculptures in the round must not exceed 8' in height and not occupy more than 12 square feet of floor space.

Identification:—Competitors must indicate clearly on the back of each entry relevant details, i.e., Name and address, title of work, price asked or N.F.S. on the sticker provided for this purpose.

Number of Entries:—In Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 a competitor may enter one painting in each section. In Sections 6 and 7 a competitor may enter more than one work in each section. In Ceramics a competitor may enter one exhibit in each Class. All exhibits must be the work of one person.

Framing:—All paintings must be framed, and sculptures suitably mounted for exhibition.

Reproduction:—The Society may allow reproduction of prize winning works to the Press and Television Stations during the period of the Exhibition.

Sale:—Works offered for sale should have the price clearly indicated. The letters N.F.S. should be used if the work is not for sale. The Society will encourage the sale of work while the Exhibition is in progress. A commission of 10% will be charged by the Society for work sold during the Exhibition.
